BROUGHTY BOWLING CLUB MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Bowling is the main function of the club and all our members are encouraged to take part in our internal competitions and if selected our external competitions. Participation is not compulsory, however, but it would help the club if you do.

During the bowling season (April to September) the club arranges friendly games against various other clubs in the local area, and we ask all of our members, where possible, to play in as many as they can manage. Participation is not compulsory, but it would help the club if you do.

The Club operates a licenced bar and is run by the members for the members. During the summer season it is open from 7.00pm Monday to Friday and at weekends if required for social events. During the winter the bar is open from 7pm on Friday. We are always looking for volunteers to serve behind the bar. This is not compulsory, but it would help the club if you do. Training will be given.

There are weekly ladies and gents club games and occasionally mixed games. For historical reasons these are referred to as wapinschaws (weapon shows.....). These games are a good way of being introduced to the game of bowling, while meeting other club members in a non-competitive environment. You are welcome to participate.

The club also arranges a number of internal competitions, which are more competitive and wherever possible you are encouraged to take part. Participation is not compulsory, however, but it would help the club if you do.

Although the club is run by a management committee, they are all volunteers. The club requires support from all of its members throughout the year (not just the bowling season) and it would be helpful if everyone offered to assist with the wide range of tasks required to maintain the business of the club, its buildings and environment, whenever they can.

Once your application has been accepted, you will be introduced to the other members of the club, given a locker for your personal items, bowls equipment etc. The basic protocols of the club will be explained including the need for security awareness etc.
