

The following Bowls Scotland/Scottish Government Guidelines have been updated (Phase 3) and take effect from 13 July 2020.

It is essential that everyone continues to adhere to the guidance and abide to the 2 metre social distancing rules at all times.

We urge everyone to remain respectful of the guidelines.

Key points to note:

- The Clubhouse and toilets will remain closed at this time.
- Arrangements will be made for members to access the clubhouse under supervision to remove their personal bowling equipment. You can do this when you arrive to play bowls with an advance rink booking. Once removed, members will be required to take their bowls, shoes etc home. No further access will be permitted to the clubhouse.
- To comply with Contact Tracing, members who wish to bowl must book a rink in advance, **under no circumstances** should anyone turn up to play without a reservation. (See separate guidance on advance booking) All members playing are required to provide emergency contact details. (See Disclaimer form which must be completed by all members who wish to play bowls on the green)
- Spectators are now permitted but they must adhere to the social distancing rules. Visitors names will be recorded for Trace and Contact purposes.
- All sessions will last for 2 hours, (10 minutes preparation, 90 minutes bowling and 20 minutes cleaning and leaving the club).
- Only four rinks will be operational at any one time.
- Rink Sessions will be available 2pm to 4pm and 6pm to 8pm Monday to Friday. Saturday 2pm to 4pm only and no bowling on Sunday.
- A maximum 4 players will now be permitted to play on each rink. (From 4 households)
- No competitive games are allowed – bounce games only.
- All sessions will be supervised by a member of the Committee or other club member nominated to do so by the Committee.

- Members **who have a rink reservation** should arrive at the start time of the session. **(Do not arrive early.)**
- All benches, walls, banks and tables in the grounds are out of use – do not touch or sit on them.
 - **Seating will be made available for members who require to sit down to change their shoes. Social distancing rules apply and cleaning will take place immediately after use.**

Advance Booking:

- A rink must be booked in advance – do not arrive at the green without a reservation.
- A rink reservation can be made by emailing the Match Secretary, Mark Watson at Gentsmatchsecretary@broughtybc.com or phone 737539 only if you don't have access to email.
- Rink reservations for the next available day must be made by 4pm the previous day.
- You can only book three days ahead.
- Where possible Rink allocations will be posted on the Club Website by 7pm the day before play– Go to Events on the top line of the home page – then click Diary – A sheet will appear for each day.
- You can book a rink for yourself and three other members. You may have to play with others if insufficient rinks are available for your particular request.
- It should also be noted that you may not get every rink allocation you request if demand for rinks is high.

Duties of Supervisor:

- Arrive at least 15 minutes before the start of a session.
- Open and secure clubhouse gate.
- Mats and jacks will be positioned on the green prior to start of daily sessions for you.
- Record the names of members present. (Sheets to be passed to the Secretary.)
- On the first occasion a member plays make sure they sign a Disclaimer form and provide emergency contact details.
- Ensure members comply with the **'Keeping Safe'** Guidance.
- Clean the seating provided for members to change their shoes immediately after each person has used it.
- After the final session, the mats and jacks will be disinfected by Duty Supervisor.

Keeping Safe Guidance:

- Travel to the Club should be within the Phase 2 Guidelines which remains at 5 miles.
- Maintain social distancing at all times.
- Please use the sanitiser provided by the club should you require to use it.
- No First Aid will be provided at the club.
- Only 4 rinks will be available for play at any time.
- **Only attend the club to play if you have a rink reservation.**
- Arrive at the start time of your booked session.
- Please do not sit or touch any walls, banks, tables or benches in the club grounds
- Players should enter all rinks from the Albert Road end nearest the clubhouse.
- Mats should be left in situ during the whole session. (Do not touch or move the mats)
- Two jacks will be available on each rink – the jacks should be set by foot.
- Games must end at the allotted time.
